To be organized by the **English Literary Society** of the **Department of English, Hindu Kanya College, Kapurthala** on **Friday, 24th January 2025.**

GENERAL RULES:

1. The participation is open for all college students.
2. There will be six competitions.
3. Student can participate in maximum two competitions of the event.
4. Last Date of Registration through Google form link provided in the Pamphlet of Wordsmith's Arena is **21st January 2024**. The registration link is also available on portal, i.e., at www.hindukanyacollege.com. Only registered participants will be allowed to participate in the event.
5. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding for all.
6. Participation certificates will be given to all participants. Trophies will be awarded to all the winners.
7. Participants will be joined in the WhatsApp group after received the registration details and the further instructions relating to event will be conveyed to all registered students through WhatsApp group only.

RULES OF ALL COMPETITIONS

Competition No. -1: QUIZ WHIZ

Quiz based on English Language and Literature

1. A team of two participants from a college is allowed.
2. There will be a Preliminary Round to select the best four teams for the On-Stage quiz.
3. The On-stage quiz will have five rounds based on multiple choice questions, one- word answers, completion of famous English line/quote/ idiom and visual/ pictorial questions.
4. In every round, each team will be asked two questions.
5. Round-wise rules will be detailed on the spot.

Competition No. -2: SPELL BEE: “Be the Wizard of Words”

1. ONLY ONE participant from a college is allowed.
2. There will be a Preliminary Round to select the best four spellers for the On-Stage Spell Bee.
3. The On-Stage Spell Bee will be based on four rounds: Spell the Words, Unjumble the Jumbled words, Fill the Missing Letters or Complete the Word and Rapid-Fire Round.
4. In first three rounds, each speller will be asked three questions.
5. In the Rapid-Fire Round, each speller will be asked to spell as many as words announced by the event-master in the 20 seconds.
6. Round-wise rules will be detailed on the spot.

Competition No. -3: CULTURAL CONFLUENCE:

Fusion Dance Competition on English songs with the fusion of Indian dances

1. The team, comprising of maximum 5 students can participate.
2. The dance style should be a fusion of Indian classical/regional with the sound track of any decent Western/English song.
3. Participants will bring their recorded music in pen drive.
4. Duration of performance will be 4-5 minutes only.
5. The judgement will be based on the presentation, coordination, creativity, choice of song and costume.

Competition No. -4: ROLE PLAY: “Act, React and Interact”

1. ONLY ONE participant from a college is allowed.
2. The participant must present a character from a famous English work (e.g. novel/play/ poem).
3. Time to present the character: 1 minute.
4. The participant must speak lines from the original work, without any modifications or additions.
5. Costumes and props must be as per the character.
6. The participant will be judged on performance, character portrayal, choice of costume and overall impact.
7. The participant must announce his/her tag number and the character he/she is portraying before starting the performance.

Competition No. -5: LITERARY LEGENDS

PowerPoint Presentation on Literary Legends Writing in English:

1. ONLY ONE participant from a college is allowed.
2. Participant must bring a backup copy of their PPT.
3. Participant cannot use notes for explanation.
4. Presentation time must be 4- 5 minutes.
5. Limit of PPT slides: 10-15 slides (including title slide and bibliography).
6. Content should include a brief biography of the selected Literary Legend, his/ her works, achievements, and awards with supporting images.
7. Judging Criteria will be based on Content (30%), Presentation Skills (30%), Visual Aids and Design (20%), Audience Engagement (10%) & Time Management (10%)

Competition No. -6: POETIC PUNCH: English Poetry Writing Competition

1. ONLY ONE participant from a college is allowed.
2. Topic to write the poem will be given on the spot.
3. Maximum time to write the poem will be One hour.
4. Participants will bring writing instruments only. Paper will be provided by the organizers.
5. Judging Criteria will be based on adherence to theme, poetic creativity, originality, clarity of imagery/feet and linguistic prowess.
