Outcome – It encouraged students to participate in electoral process of the nation.

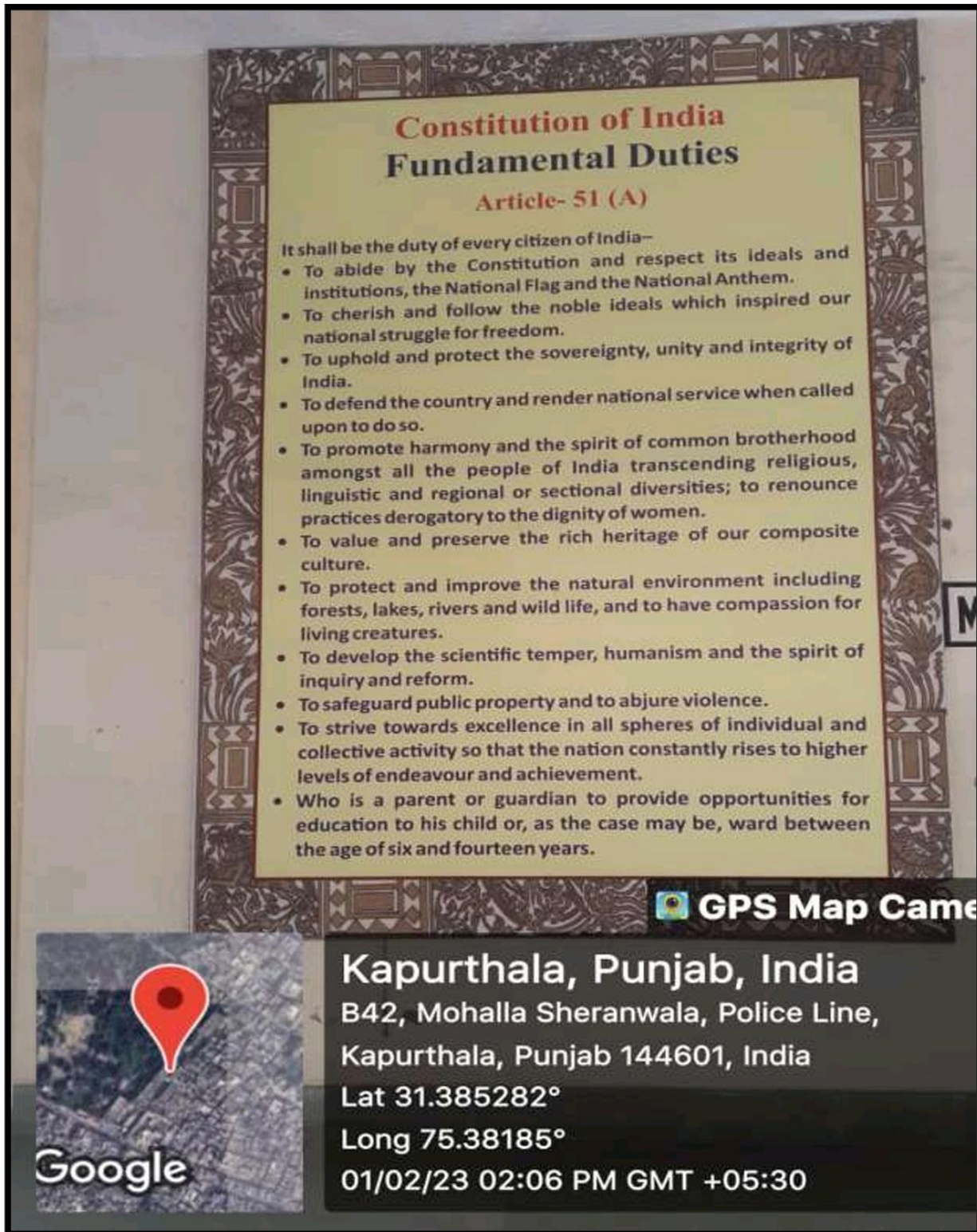

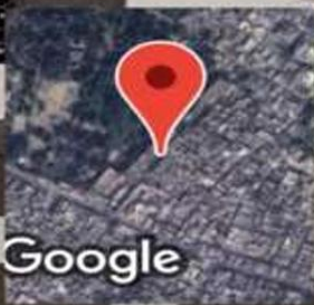
